

OCRACOKE RENDEZVOUS INFORMATION

Bill Gilbert of the Anchorage Marina and Inn in Ocracoke, has sent the following information about our June 25 - 28 rendezvous. We will send more information about details, but if you are ready to make your reservation, go ahead. Be sure to identify yourself as a member of PSPS:

Dear Mr. Miller:

I would like to take this opportunity to follow up on our phone conversations from last year where we discussed the Pamlico Sail & Power Squadron's plans to visit The Anchorage Inn and Marina, on Ocracoke Island, this summer. Tentatively we have marked off 15 boat slips and 5 rooms for your group to arrive on Thursday, 6/25/09, and depart on Sunday, 6/28/09

We will reopen The Anchorage Inn and Marina in March for the 2009 season and will hold the rooms and slips until May 1, 2009 to make sure everyone with your group has a chance to make their individual reservation. Dockage rates at The Anchorage Marina have increased, however we will give you the same discounted rate as last year which was \$2.25 per foot per night which includes electric, water, use of showers, and use of the swimming pool.

We will also give your group the following discounted Room rates at The Anchorage Inn:
