The Pamlico Sail & Power Squadron Website is being transitioned from the current Adobe Dreamweaver & Contribute software to Joomla software. This is the same software used to develop the USPS National web site. The current software would require investment dollars to continue to be supported. The great news is that Joomla is free and much less restrictive to maintain. Steve Neckyfarow, our Webmaster, has worked for many months now researching and setting up the structure that allowed us to move our current pages to the new site and maintain a similar look and feel.

In addition to the ability to maintain a similar look and navigation within the site, we will have for the first time a "Member's Only" section of the web site. This will be managed with individual member user identification and password.

In order to access the Member Only section, go to the Login Form on the Home Page only in the right column, lower portion of the page. Click on "Create an account" and enter your Username (suggest last name so both you and your spouse can use it), then enter a password of your choice, containing 10 characters that is easily remembered. We suggest you **do not** use a password that you use on other secure websites since this site does not use "https".

Our Webmaster will receive an email requesting a member approval for Login, he will notify you of approval.

You are ready to go anytime you visit the site and Login. The information available under the Member Only section is the Photo Gallery, PSPS Roster and the PSPS Bylaws. Of course, to review all other pages besides the “Member only” there is no Login required.

The Calendar has a completely new look and gives the flexibility of adding and changing events as they occur. When clicking on a particular event, example Partner In Command on 10/24, you will need to click on the Flyer link for more details.
